* Important Z-Club Information *

Z Club is a school service organization in which students work on specific Z Club projects and earn service hours in order to maintain their membership in the organization. The purpose of the Z Club is to introduce students to volunteer service, to develop leadership skills, and to contribute to the local, national, and international communities through club-determined service projects. Our hope is to bring about awareness through these projects and make positive changes in the world because of our involvement.

Requirements: (Must be met by every member)

- Complete application and pay dues by second meeting. T-shirts are available for order, if desired.
- Earn at least 7 hours of service by Christmas break and a total of 15 service hours by the end of April.
- Service hours must be Z-Club service projects. Your own personal volunteering does not count toward Z Club. *You can only earn hours by completing projects planned and organized by the club.* Volunteering at school concessions is permitted/encouraged (with a signed slip) BUT you may only earn half of your service hours this way. Any questions, please ask.
- You must attend at least 6 meetings throughout the year and continue to attend meetings on a regular basis after you have met this requirement. You will earn 15 minutes of service for each meeting you attend. (Attendance begins at the second meeting of the year when we have our membership list.) Attendance is taken at 7:18 a.m.
- It is very important that when you sign up for a project/event that you show up. People are counting on you! If you sign up for project or volunteer to bring something in and you don't, the first time it happens you will receive a warning. If this happens again, the time scheduled will be deducted from your Z-Club hours!!! If you are able to find someone else to take your shift or time slot, you will be excused but please make sure the person filling in for you makes it known.
- All members must work or participate in the spring track concession held at LBHS. This is our only fundraiser for scholarships. If you unable to work the concession stand, you may help with purchasing items and setting/clean up – See Advisor.
- If you earn 15 service hours by the end of May, you will receive a Z-Club certificate at the banquet.

If you are heavily involved in sports or a job, it may be difficult for you to attend some of our service projects. Below are other ways you can earn Z Club hours.

Put your name on all bags or boxes, and also where they are to go. Limit of bringing in items is 3 hours. Items are due by December 1. Turn in all receipts for items you purchased.

1. During the canned food drive in November, bring in an extra 20 cans of food like soup, canned vegetables, canned fruit, etc. = 1 hour. Small tomato paste cans and similar items will be counted as a half of a can.
2. For Open Arms children: Put together a box of items for a boy or a girl. (Toothbrush and paste, pajamas, shampoo, comb/brush, a few personal items like books, games or school supplies) Items must be new and valued at \$15-20 = 1 hour.
3. For Open Arms women: Put together a box of items (Suggested items might be: lotion, hair products, make-up, toothbrush and paste, brushes, gift cards for gas, phone or groceries.) Items must be new and valued at \$15-20 = 1 hour.
4. For Hope House: Put together a box of items like paper towels, laundry detergent, dish soap, bar soap, new bath towels, 13 or 33-gallon trash bags, gift cards (gas, gift and/or phone cards), diapers, over-the-counter medicine (flu, cold, aspirin etc) Items must be new and valued at \$15-20 = 1 hour.
5. Bring in a donation for any one of these causes: March of Dimes, Bowl-for-Kids or a general donation to a charitable organization of \$10 = 30 minutes / \$20 = 1 hour etc.
6. Adopt a family from the Hope House or Open Arms at Christmas. Go shopping for gifts and wrap (label gifts boy/girl etc) and deliver them. Depending on the amount you spend will determine the number of hours you will receive. You can do with a friend and split the cost and points. (Roughly \$15-20 = 1 hour)

Z-Club General Information:

Z-Club meetings begin at 7:15 a.m. on the first and third Wednesday of every month unless otherwise stated. Attendance will be taken at 7:18 a.m. If you are not in a seat by that time, you will not get hours for that meeting. You earn 15 minutes service for attendance and you must attend at least six meetings.

If we have a 2-hour delay (fog or snow) on a day when a Z-Club meeting is planned, the meeting will still take place, just two hours later! If school is cancelled on a day that a meeting is scheduled, then the meeting will take place the following day (Thursday).
